8. Exhibits may be collected from 10am to 4pm, Saturday 19 July 2008. No responsibility will be taken for exhibits left in the Arts & Crafts Pavilion after this time.

3. Dispatch or deliver completed Entry Forms including fees applicable to Cairns Show Association, PO Box 811, BUNGALOW QLD 4870.
4. Exhibitors will receive Entry or Class Cards.
5. Exhibits must be delivered with the Class Card to the designated part of the grounds by the due time and date shown.

AFTER THE SHOW
