SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. Refer General Conditions of Entry & Competition in front of schedule.
2. All intending exhibitors must immediately contact Elders to arrange for mouthing of exhibits and ear tag - Prime Beef Cattle. If desired, Entry Forms can be completed on day of mouthing. All prime beef cattle will be judged as per ear tag on day of mouthing.
3. All cattle must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
4. All cattle must remain on the grounds for exhibition until 5pm Friday 18 July 2008 at the expense of the vendor.
5. All entries are received subject to the right of the Stewards to reject any cattle not up to Show standard and if required to arrange for same to be removed from the ground before judging commences.
6. Stewards also retain the right to transfer any entry to a more suitable class.
7. All cattle will be poll or dehorned. Cattle with horns will not be judged.
8. On arrival at the grounds all cattle must be penned by the owner or his representative and all cattle transport vehicles will be required to be removed from the grounds immediately unloading is completed.
9. The following colours donated ear tagging for age:-
Orange - Milk Teeth White - 2 Teeth Blue - 4 Teeth Yellow - 6 Teeth Green - Full Mouth
10. In the event of an exhibit in any one class not being worthy of a prize, no prize money will be awarded.
11. Champions may be selected from single or pen classes.
12. No cattle are allowed as non-competitive.
13. All cattle will be weighed and lot numbered on arrival at grounds.
14. All animals exhibited to be of good general health and free of ticks and / or transmittable diseases. Use product with nil (ESI) export slaughter interval or with nil (WHP) withholding period.
15. All cattle must be available for sale.
16. Cattle cannot be entered or compete in more than one class.
17. Pasture and/or crop fed cattle that have been supplementary fed will not be exempt.
18. No dipping facilities are available at the Showgrounds, therefore exhibitors from tick free and protected areas will need to have their stock treated at a DPI line clearance centre on the way home.
19. All animals to be exhibited must be registered with the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS).

NOTE

All single entries are to be judged on quality & trade suitability. All pens are to be judged on evenness, quality & trade suitability

HOW TO ENTER

1. Fully complete the Official Entry Form.
2. Entries will not be accepted after the closing date, unless agreed to by the chief Steward.
3. Dispatch or delivery of completed Entry Forms, including fees applicable, to Cairns Show Association, PO Box 811 Bungalow Qld 4870.
4. Exhibits should be delivered via the Quigley Street loading ramp by the due time and date.
5. Prize money is paid by the Cairns Show Office after finalisation of results (usually no later than end August)
6. Where possible all exhibits should be penned or tethered prior to judging time.
