SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1. All embroidery backs must be seen except for: Classes **4** - Elizabethan Embroidery, **6** - Brazilian Embroidery, **10** - Bobbin Lace, **11** - Candlewicking, **14** - Australian Crosses or Chicken Scratching on Gingham, **15** - Silk Ribbon Embroidery, **16** - Cross Stitch Picture, **18** - Florentine on Canvas, **19** - Tapestry, **21** - Shadow Embroidery, **22** - Crazy Patchwork, **23** - Stumpwork, **24** - Reverse Applique, **28** - Red Work, **36** - Creative Gold or Silver Work, **40** - Embroidered Needlecase, **53** - Pin Prick Card.
2. Exhibits must not be attached to any backing for judging.
3. Coat hangers and supports may be used.
4. All entries to be in Show Hall by 8.30am on the day of judging.
5. QCWA logo to be displayed at the top of the bay.
6. Bay numbers to be displayed and clearly seen for judging.
7. Branch names to be displayed after judging is complete.
8. Displays to remain for the full duration of the Show. Dismantling and collection time will be 8am - 10am Saturday 19 July 2008.
9. No tickets, prize ribbons or trophies to be removed from the displays until dismantling times.
10. Points Awarded: Maximum of ten points (10) each exhibit
Maximum of ten points (10) for display
No points will be awarded for Ticketing.
11. Ticketing to be lettering 2cm Block print on white background. No black edging. Computer printouts acceptable and can be laminated.
12. Point Cards for the public to be 18cm x 12cm with black lettering. These will be available from Committee.
13. Yarn labels to be attached to exhibits if specified.
14. All exhibits to be the unaided work of a financial member of QCWA of the exhibiting branch and must have been executed within two (2) years prior to the Show, and not have been entered into any previous year same QCWA Show competition. In the event of a tie, the Handcraft Committee provide an extra prize ribbon, the Trophy (if awarded) to be held for six months by each Branch concerned.
15. All exhibits must be marked with a small tag bearing the bay number and item number as per Schedule and attached to the exhibit in a prominent place for judging, to be removed for display.
16. Copy of Schedule is to be forwarded to the Judges prior to judging in time for them to study.
17. Judges, Stewards and Recorder will be appointed by the Committee.
18. No points awarded to any item that does not comply with the Schedule.
19. The names of the maker of each item to be listed on a separate sheet with branch name and given to Handcraft Chairman.
20. Name of exhibitor should not be shown on exhibits.
21. Frames are **not** to be judged.
22. Any framed or mounted craft must not exceed 55cm x 50cm – or an area not more than 2750sq.cm.

ITEMS A: MACHINE SEWING AND ITEM B: RECYCLED ITEM ARE COMPULSORY, PLUS TEN (10) OTHERS SELECTED FROM THE SCHEDULE. TWO (2) OF THESE MUST BE HARD CRAFTS, A TOTAL OF TWELVE (12) ITEMS REQUIRED. ALL ITEMS TO BE COMPLETELY FINISHED.

Item A - Machine Sewing - Compulsory

Ladies budget dress value up to \$25 (dockets to be shown, pattern not included in \$25)

Item B - Recycled Article - Compulsory

Floor Mat - 80% recycled material (maximum size 60cm x 45cm)

- Class 30003 Hardanger - Open, can be coloured, with beads (cross stitch, embroidery allowed)**

- Class 30005 Drawn Thread - Any article**
- Class 30006 Brazilian Embroidery - Minimum of 6 different stitches**
- Class 30007 Traced Embroidery - Table centre, with crochet edge - edge to be judged**
- Class 30008 Largatera - On evenweave - finished article not to be framed**
- Class 30009 Huckaback Embroidery - Any medium, may be hemmed or fringed**
- Class 30010 Bobbin Lace**
- Class 30011 Candlewicking - Open, colours allowed, can be sculptured. No larger than 50cm x 50cm, no framed pictures or toys**
- Class 30012 Blackwork - Open, any article, not framed**
- Class 30013 Filet Net Embroidery - Open, no framed pictures, item no smaller than 25cm square. Coloured threads may be used.**
- Class 30014 Australian Crosses or Chicken Scratching on Gingham - Open colour allowed. Tablecloths allowed.**
- Class 30015 Silk Ribbon Embroidery - Any item, threads and beads allowed**
- Class 30016 Cross Stitch Picture - Any medium, framed**
- Class 30017 Jacobean Embroidery - Any article**
- Class 30018 Florentine on Canvas - Any item, 3 colours, any number of shades, not framed**
- Class 30019 Tapestry**
- Class 30020 Machine Made Bag - Must be hand decorated, any medium**
- Class 30021 Shadow Embroidery - Any item**
- Class 30022 Crazy Patchwork - Any item up to 50cm x 50cm, hand embroidered, embellishments allowed**
- Class 30023 Stumpwork**
- Class 30024 Reverse Applique - Any item up to 50cm x 50cm**
- Class 30025 Tatting - Any item, minimum 10cm**
- Class 30026 Crochet Table Centre - up to 50cm across using No. 20, 30 or 40 cotton, may have beads**
- Class 30027 Crochet Doiley Fine - Using No. 60 cotton or finer, no smaller than 15cm and no larger than 30cm - no beads**
- Class 30028 Red Work - Any medium, any item, no framed pictures - no larger than 50cm square**
- Class 30029 Knitted Lace - Any item - minimum 25cm, no bedspreads**
- Class 30030 Knitted or Crochet Tea Cosy or Cover - Must be lined**
- Class 30031 Mount Mellick - Up to 50cm**
- Class 30032 Traditional Fur Fabric Bear - Bow allowed, up to 50cm**
- Class 30033 Modern Rag Doll - Painted face, can be machine stitched, up to 50cm tall**
- Class 30034 Best Knitted or Crochet Toy - Any medium up to 50cm**
- Class 30035 Handkerchief Edge - Any medium, not to exceed 2.5cm**
- Class 30036 Creative Gold or Silver Work - Any item**
- Class 30037 Adults Knitted Sleeveless Waistcoat - Wool / wool blend, synthetic, buttons**
- Class 30038 Crochet Knee Rug - Can include any crochet technique, no larger than 135cm x 135cm or 18225sq.cm area, any medium, no fringe allowed.**
- Class 30039 Knitted Article - Using fancy yarns**
- Class 30040 Embroidered Needlecase - Any medium**
- Class 30041 Parchment - Any item, embellishments allowed, not framed**
- Class 30042 Unicraft Article - Any medium, minimum 10cm, maximum 40cm**
- Class 30043 Bead Novelty - Not knitted or crochet**

Class 30044 Beadwork Jewellery - Necklace, not boxed or cardboard backed
Class 30045 Brooch - Any hard craft
Class 30046 Knitted or Crochet Bead Novelty
Class 30047 Paper Tole or Quilling Picture - Framed
Class 30048 Christmas Tree Decoration - To hang on Tree, any medium, up to 15cm
Class 30049 Scrap Booking - Double page, each page 30cm x 30cm
Class 30050 Set of Three (3) Cards and Envelopes - 3 distinct techniques and medium
Class 30051 Silk Painting - Any article
Class 30052 Painting - Any medium, 2750sq.cm
Class 30053 Pin Prick Card - Any technique, any medium
Class 30054 Any Soft Craft - Not previously mentioned in Schedule, no larger than 50cm x 50 cm
Class 30055 Any Hard Craft - Not previously mentioned in Schedule, no larger than 50cm x 50 cm
Class 30056 Any Soft Craft - Made by member under 8 years, age of exhibitor to be attached to article
Class 30057 Any Soft Craft - Made by member 8 - 12 years, age of exhibitor to be attached to article
Class 30058 Any Soft Craft - Made by member 12 - 18 years, age of exhibitor to be attached to article
Class 30059 Any Hard Craft - Made by member under 8 years, age of exhibitor to be attached to article
